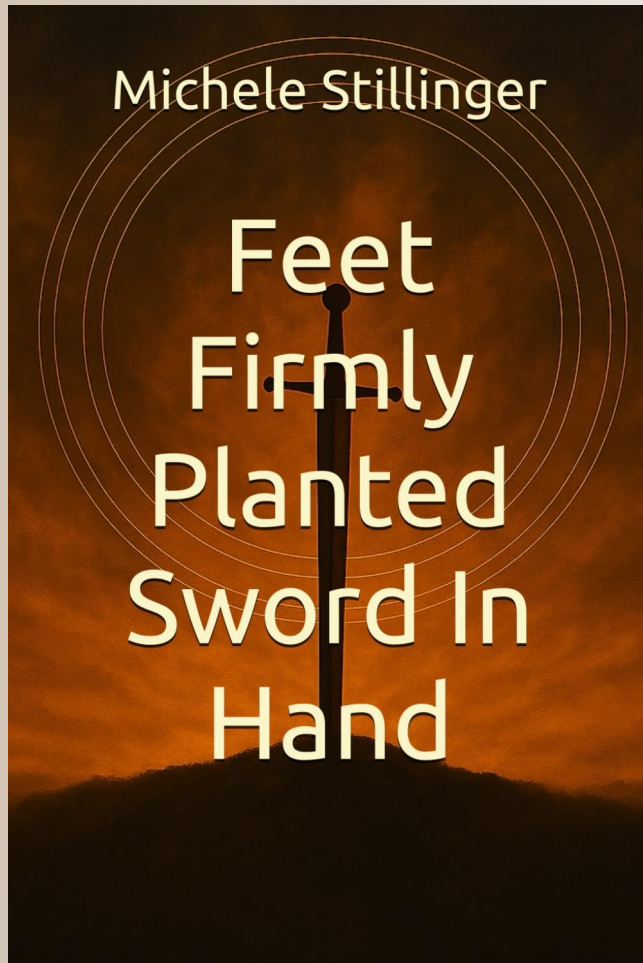

Feet Firmly Planted, Sword in Hand is an invitation to join me in that same practice. You will not find lofty language or rigid formulas here. Instead, you will find:

Key scriptures that anchor each theme.

Short reflections that connect God's truth to everyday life.

Sample prayers rooted in the Bible, showing how to speak God's Word back to Him.

Your Turn prompts that encourage you to write your own prayers and reflections.

Scripture Helps pages that gather additional verses for deeper prayer.

In those tender seasons, He gave me five simple anchors that steadied me when everything else felt uncertain. I call them the **Five C's**:

Christ – turning to Jesus as the foundation of hope and the presence that never leaves.

Cardio – moving my body in gentle ways, reminding me that life continues one step at a time.

Contact – reaching out to friends, prayer partners, or community, because grief was never meant to be carried alone.

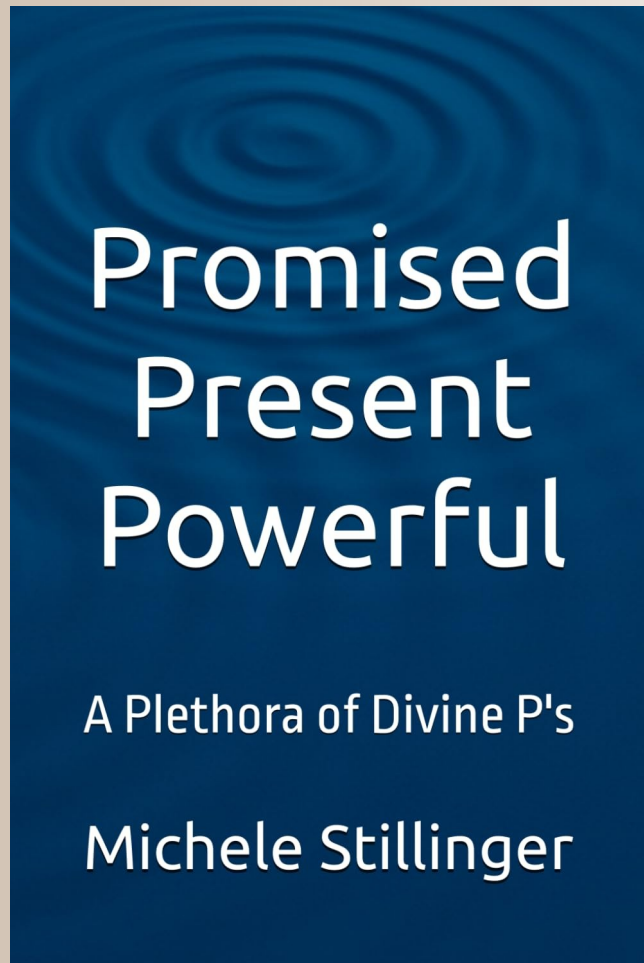
Chore – finding strength in simple routines that ground me in the ordinary moments of life.

Craft – creating beauty through hobbies, art, or writing, opening my heart to God's healing touch.

This devotional is not a quick fix for sorrow. It is an invitation to walk with God through your grief—honestly, gently, and day by day. Each entry offers a Scripture to anchor your heart, a reflection to guide your thoughts, space to write your own prayers, and encouragement to practice the Five C's in your everyday life.

A key verse from Scripture

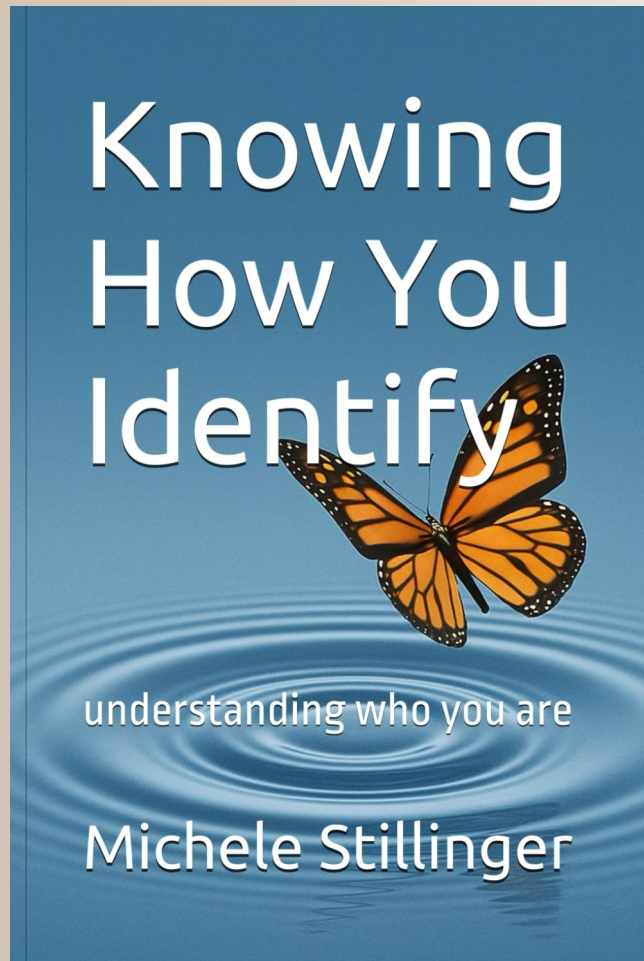
A reflection written in a warm, conversational style

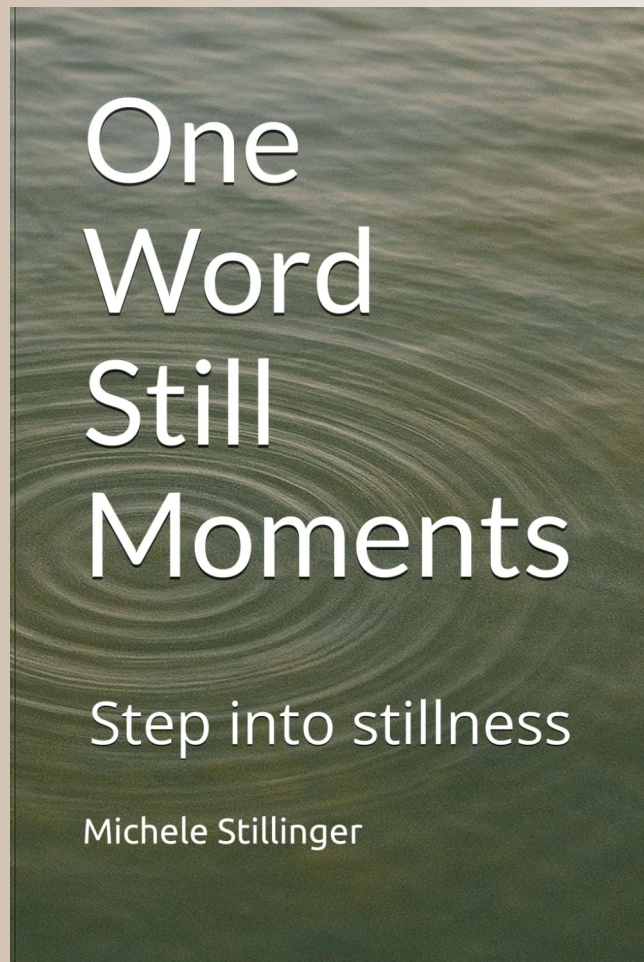
Write your prayers—opposite every entry you’ll find a full, lined page (with a tiny butterfly page-number icon) for journaling, prayer notes, or creative response.

Prayer that draws your heart into stillness and intimacy with the Lord

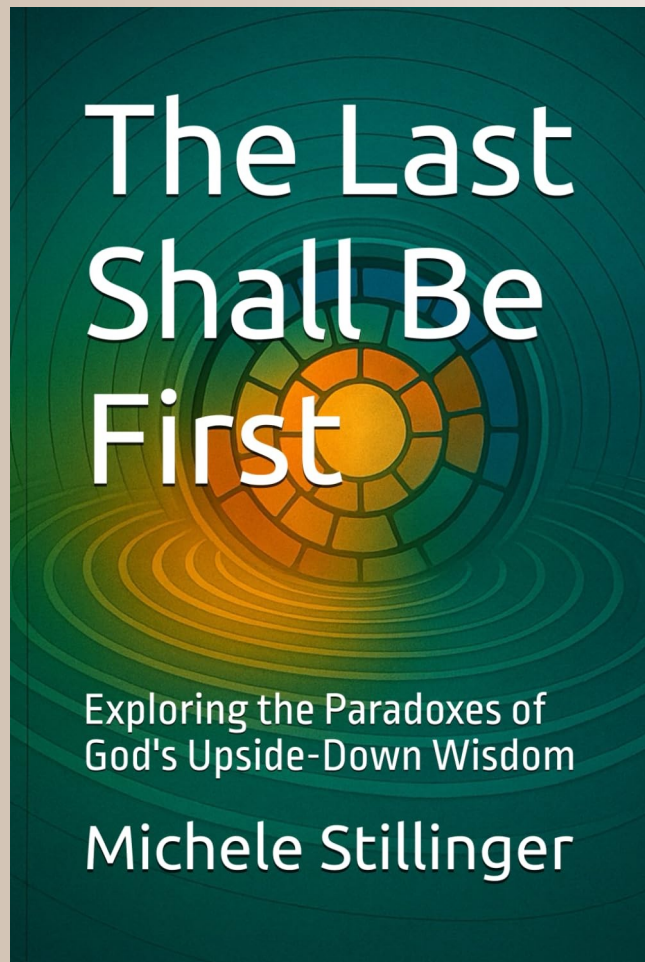
