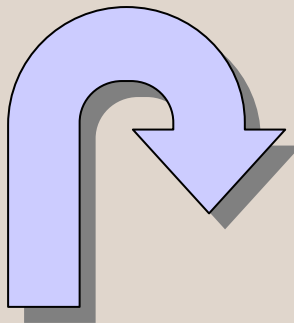

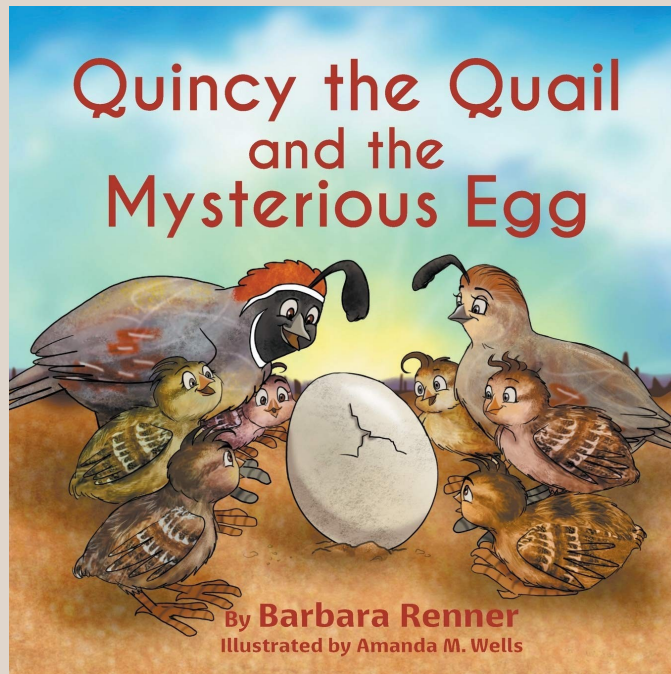

Mysterious Egg*



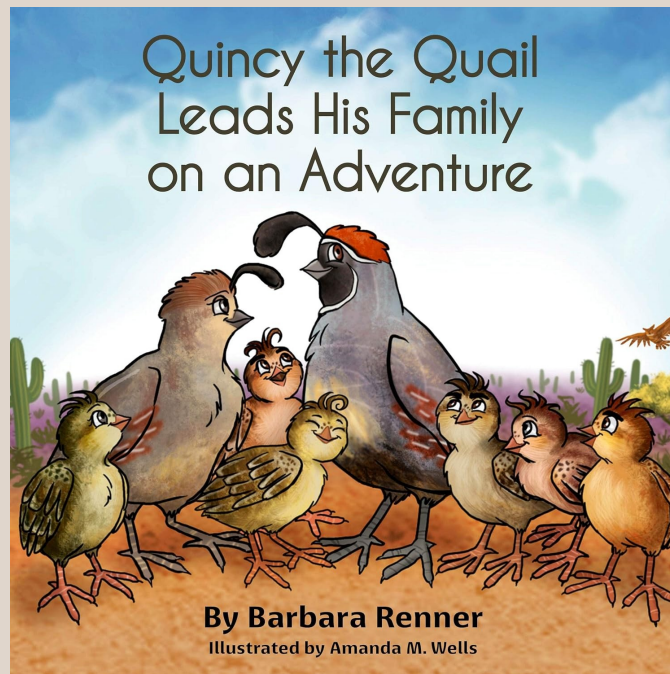
What would you do if you found a huge egg in your yard?

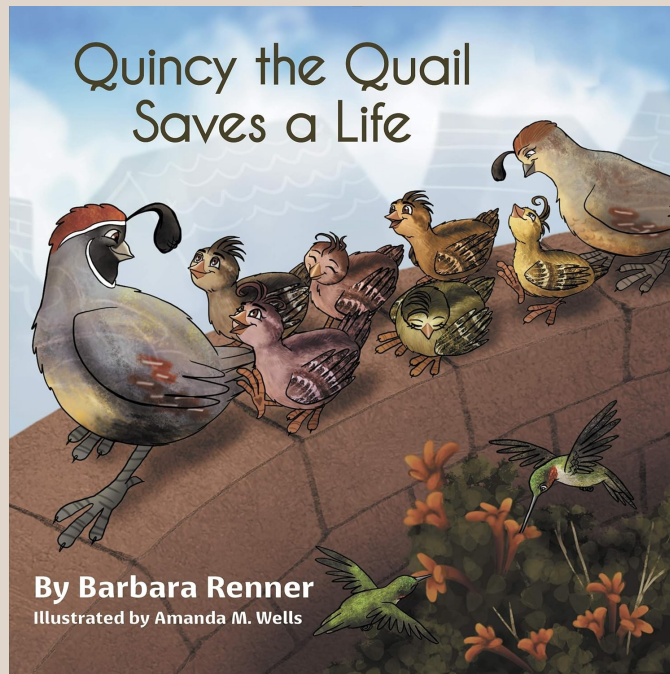

When Quincy the Quail leads his family to a new territory to hunt for food, they encounter a bullying hummingbird.

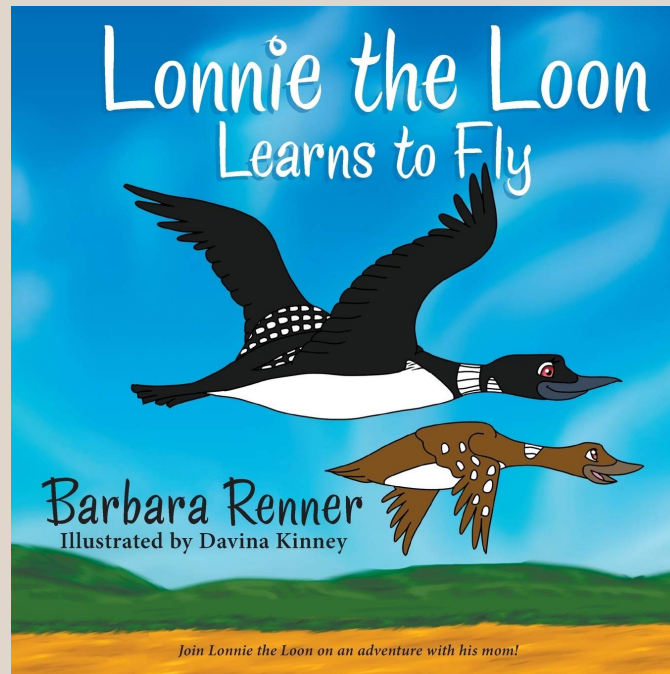

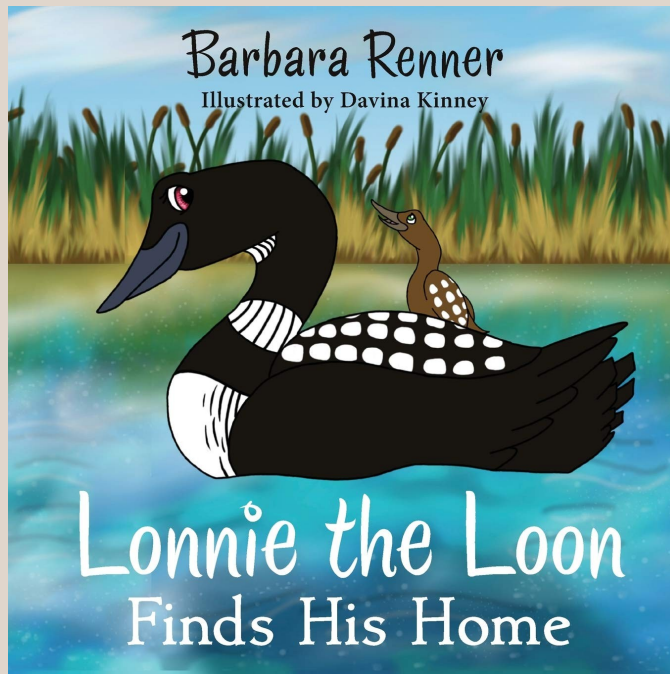
The reader is able to listen to the calls and sounds of the desert animals using a QR Code Reader App.

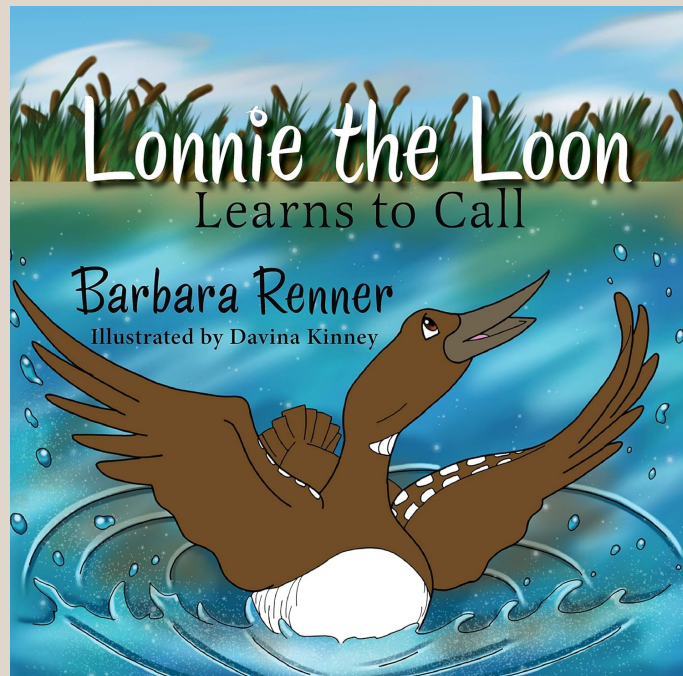

Time to Build a Nest



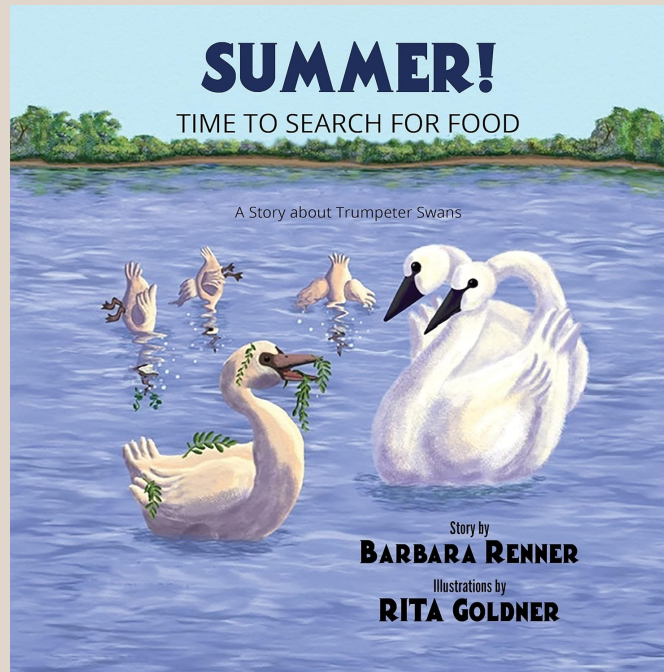

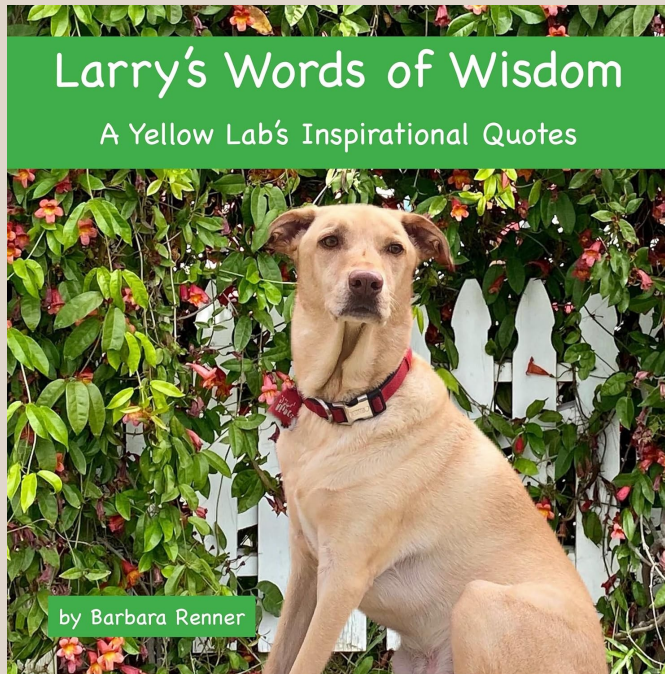

Larry's Words of Wisdom



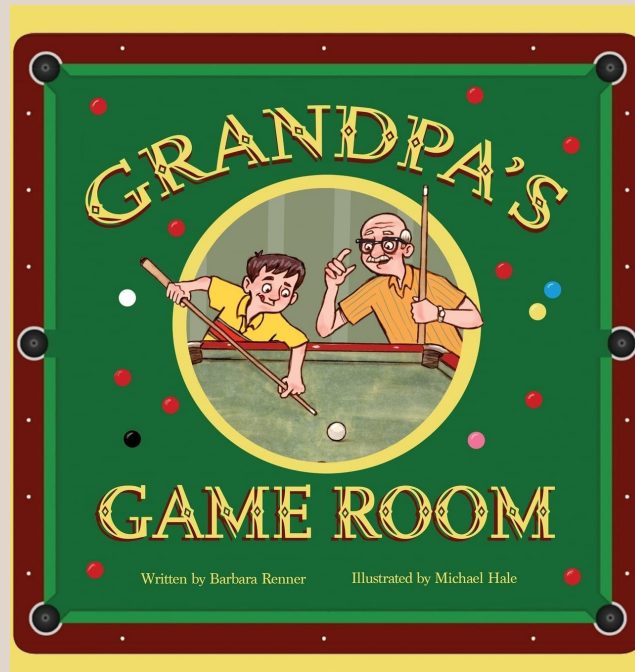

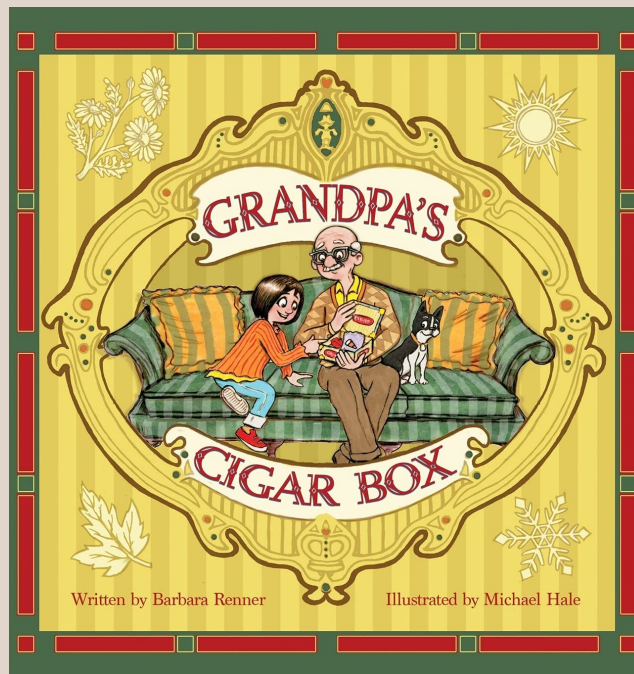

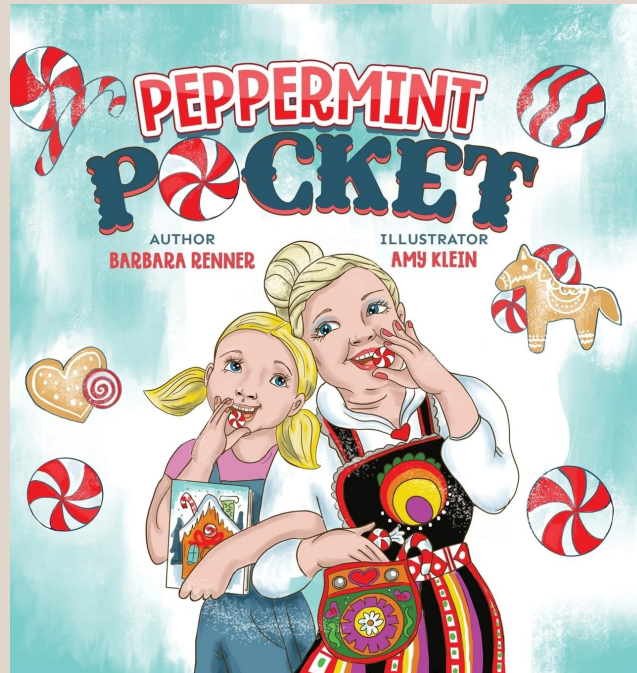
